Troop 160 / Troop 1600 – 2024 Registration Fee and Fundraiser Information

Hello, Troop 160/1600 member,

Planning for our Scouting year is off to a great start, and I'm excited for the many adventures that await our Scouts and Troops this year. I want to take this opportunity to outline this year's Troop registration fee and program costs. The fees our Troops pay to BSA National/NEPA Council to register your Scout(s) is \$130. In addition to that registration fee, our Troop committee anticipates spending an additional \$125 - \$150 in program costs per Scout for things such as badges, camping trips/food, event registration fees, equipment, etc. After carefully reviewing all these fees/costs the Troops Committee has decided to set the scout registration fee at \$250 per scout. With your paid registration, you will be issued a set of tickets for our only fundraiser – our annual French Toast Breakfast. You will receive seven adult, and six youth French Toast Breakfast tickets valued at \$120. You can choose to sell these tickets and keep the money or use them to host family and friends for a great breakfast!

The French Toast Breakfast (FTB) Fundraiser will be held on November 9th from 7-11:30 a.m. with setup on November 7th during the Troop meeting. The FTB will not only require many Scouts and Scouters to work the event, but we will also need all members to support it by selling additional tickets and ham sponsorships. Scouts will earn a commission of 33% of all ticket/ham sales with those monies going into their Scout Account to be used to pay for special trips, trainings, or summer camp. Adult tickets are \$12, youth tickets \$6 and Ham Sponsorships are \$30 ea. Additional tickets and Ham Sponsorships are available and will be issued by our Troop Treasurer, Mr. Stankowski, or Assist Scoutmaster Mr. Jones. This breakfast is a great community event and one that is embraced by so many because of the friendly atmosphere and great food. As stated earlier, the FTB is the only fundraiser that is planned for the year, so we ask that all families get involved and support it. There will be more specific information sent soon regarding our registration and FTB, so please stay tuned for those announcements.
