

Basic Gear List:

The following is a basic gear list for most events\campouts. Please always check with the event\campout coordinator for additional equipment or special instructions.

- Complete Boy Scout Class A uniform if need for event
- 2 pairs of official Boy Scout Socks or socks appropriate for event or weather conditions
- Clothes for seven days in a waterproof foot locker or a container to keep clothes dry
- Troop 160 T-shirt
- Jacket, Sweater or sweatshirt
- Hiking boot, sneakers
- Rain Gear
- Sleeping bag appropriate rating for campout
- Toilet Kit (toothbrush, toothpaste, towel, soap etc.)
- Tent
- Ground cloth\tarp
- Cot if needed
- Rope for clothes line 25 feet
- Backpack
- Day pack (old book bag will work)
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Pocketknife. Blade cannot be longer than 3 inches (must have your toten chip card)
- Watch
- Compass
- Pen, Pencil, Notebook for merit badges
- Boy Scout Handbook
- Spending Money if needed
- Water\Nalgene bottle
- Hat
- Insect repellent (non-aerosol)
- Sunscreen (non-aerosol)
- Medications. Must be in the original container and clearly marked.
- Extra pair of eyeglasses
- Personal First Aid Kit

What not to bring:

- **Any type of aerosol including, but not limited to: insect repellent, sunscreen, body spray, and hair spray.**
- **No Alcohol based products including but not limited to hand sanitizers.**
- **Radio's, Game boy's, walkie-talkies, IPod's, MP3 players etc.**
