Ages 6 to 10 (Twelve Children): Individually wrapped Easter candy, coloring books, small toys - cars, action figures, stuffed animals, puzzles, toiletries, etc.

Ages 11 to 14 (Nine Children): Individually wrapped Easter candy, board games, gift cards, sports balls, toys, arts and crafts, puzzles, toiletries, etc.

Age 15 and Up (Nine Children): Individually wrapped Easter candy, gift cards to places like McDonald's, Dunkin Donuts, school supplies, toiletries, etc.
